



## PRESS RELEASE:

In April and May 2016, the *Sound Circle Eurythmy Ensemble* will present its latest touring program, *Shapeshifting*, in Colorado, before touring to Mexico and Switzerland in June. A few details:

- **WHAT:** This year, the *Ensemble* is presenting **three** different programs, all entitled ***Shapeshifting/Transformaciones***: two children's programs, mostly to be presented during the school day, and an evening program for the general public. All are **bi-lingual English-Spanish** and will feature Latin-American/Spanish composers Isaac Albéniz, Enrique Granados, and Astor Piazzola; and poetry by Miguel Hernández, Octavio Paz, Juan Ramón Jiménez, and US poet Langston Hughes, etc. All three will also feature a bi-lingual version of the Catalan story of ***The Girl-Fish***, created especially for this tour, with original music by Boulder composer Alan Cole. For the school performances, copies of the texts will be sent ahead upon request, so teachers/parents may use them to prepare the children.
- **WHO:** The *SCE Ensemble* is made up of a few professional eurythmists, who will be joined for this program by 4<sup>th</sup>-Year students from the *SCE* full-time Training program. They will be accompanied by a pianist, two speakers/narrators, and a lighting technician.
- **WHERE:** Venues for this tour include the *Lakewood Cultural Center (Lakewood)*, *Bas Bleu Theatre (Fort Collins)*, *Mountain Song Community School (Colorado Springs)*, *Juniper Ridge Community School (Grand Junction)*, and the *Kelly Barn (Boulder)*.
